

Notification of Indoor (Theatrical) Fireworks Display

When notifying Liverpool City Council of an Indoor (Theatrical) Fireworks Display, complete this checklist and submit it to Council at least 7 business days before an Indoor Fireworks Display.

Council will consider the impacts of the proposed display then inform SafeWork NSW and the pyrotechnician of its support/objection. A separate risk assessment and proof of public liability insurance may be requested.
