The Harmony Cup 2026 is a football tournament and cultural festival delivered by Liverpool City Council, bringing together players, families, schools and communities from across South West Sydney.

THE EVENT FEATURES THREE KEY COMPONENTS:

MEN'S CUP

The Harmony Cup 2026 is a community football tournament designed to promote social cohesion, cultural connection, community participation, and healthy competition through sport.

Delivered as a one-day football showcase at Hammondville Oval, the event will bring together community teams, families and spectators for a day of competition, inclusion and community celebration, culminating in the Harmony Cup Grand Final and presentation ceremony.
