

In accordance with section 6(5) of the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009* (GIPA Act), Liverpool City Council must keep a record of any open access information that it does not make publicly available on the basis that there is an overriding public interest against disclosure.

The following table details open access information not disclosed due to an overriding public interest against disclosure:

1	Under schedule 1(2)(a) of the <i>Government Information (Public Access) Regulations 2018</i> , information contained in returns of the interests of councillors, designated persons, and delegates, is prescribed as open access information.	Several details in Council's written returns have not been disclosed for privacy protection purposes. For example, if a staff member is concerned that the disclosure of their residential address would place or places their personal or family's safety at risk, they can apply to the General Manager under section 739 of the <i>Local Government Act 1993</i> , to have information restricted.
