

Terms and conditions

1. Entry to the Liverpool Christmas Lights Competition is free.
2. Entries must be located within Liverpool City Council Local Government Area
3. Liverpool City Council staff or their immediate families; sponsors, and elected members are not permitted to enter.
4. Applicants will be required to submit a completed online Christmas Lights Competition entry form and photos of the decorated property by the due date. No late entries will be allowed.
5. Application forms will be made available from Liverpool City Council's website.
6. Entries will be judged by photo submissions only and only the photos submitted with the online form at the time of entry will be considered.
7. By completing the online form and submitting images for the Liverpool Christmas Lights Competition, the entrant consents to said images being used in promotional marketing.
8. Liverpool City Council, nor the parties involved, will accept any responsibility or will be liable for any injury, loss or damage to an entrant's property as a result of participation in the Liverpool Christmas Lights Competition.
9. An internal panel of Liverpool City Council judges will decide the winners.
10. All prizes are awarded at the discretion of the Judging Panel, whose decision will be final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
11. Entry and winners photographs may be reproduced in Liverpool City Council website, social media channels, published in local media and used as promotional material by Council at its discretion. These items remain the property of Liverpool City Council.
12. If requested, a successful applicant will also be available or willing to make a representative available for publicity purposes either in the local media or in a Council publication or other promotional material.
13. Three (3) residential addresses will be awarded a cash prize of \$500 each.
14. The website will be updated ready for winners' announcements on social media.
15. Winners will be announced on social media through a post or video. A small editorial will feature may be produced which can also depict judging panel comments.
16. Winners will then be contacted to coordinate prize collection.
17. Applicants can choose to participate in the Christmas Lights Trail. Consenting will mean that their address will be published on Council's website.
