

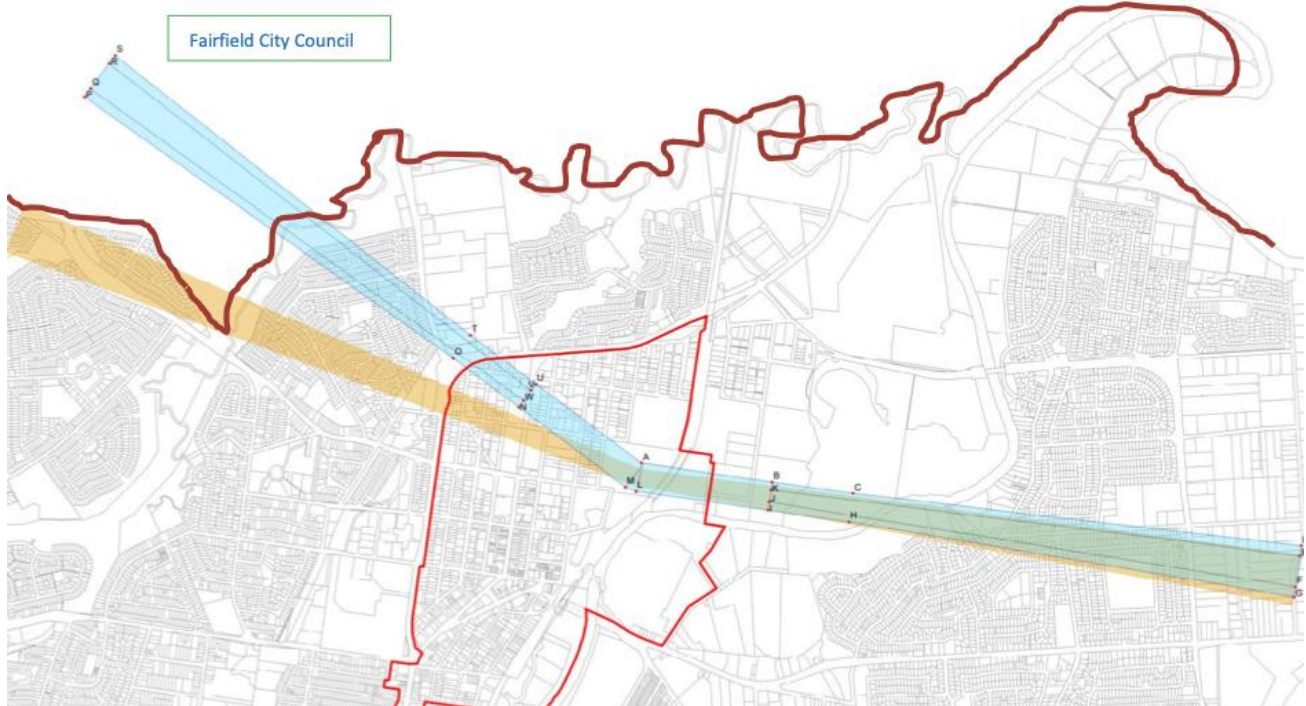
Liverpool Local Environmental Plan 2008 – Key Site Map Amendment

Liverpool City Council is exhibiting a draft Key Site Map Amendment to the Liverpool Local Environmental Plan 2008 (LEP). Council invites members of the public to view the proposal and provide feedback.

What is the Liverpool Local Environmental Plan?

The LEP contains zoning and planning controls which guide development for most of the local government area. Some of the LEP controls include the types of development permitted on a particular site, including the floor space and height to which a development can be constructed.

What changes are proposed?

This draft amendment seeks to formalise the realignment of the Liverpool Hospital helicopter flight path by moving the location and extent of the contours as shown on the relevant Key Site Maps of the LEP.
