

To book a **FREE** clean-up collection contact Council on **1300 36 2170**.

You must comply with the following:

- Items for collection **MUST ONLY** be placed out the evening before the collection date. You are given this when you make your booking.
- All collection types **MUST** be booked separately and separated when presented to kerbside.
- Materials **MUST NOT** exceed two cubic metres (2m long x 1m wide x 1m high, roughly the amount contained in a box trailer load).
- Two people must be able to carry each of the items.
- Materials **MUST** be piled neatly on the nature strip, clear of pedestrian and vehicle access as well as obstacles including trees and power-poles.
- Only place **CORRECT** items out for collection, **INCORRECT** items will not be collected and will be your responsibility to dispose of.

Non-compliance may result in further action being taken. Penalties may apply.

# HOUSEHOLD CLEAN-UP COLLECTION SERVICE

Liverpool Council offers a **FREE** clean-up service for residents on request for three separate categories.

If you do not understand this brochure, please ring the Telephone Interpreter Service (131 450) and ask them to contact Council (1300 36 2170).

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Council's FREE clean-up service is available for you to dispose of larger household waste items that need to be collected and cannot be reused or recycled. You must make a booking for these services.

## 1 GENERAL WASTE

Council will collect up to two cubic metres of general household material. These collections are limited to two per year per household.

The following will be collected:

- Furniture
- Floor coverings
- Loose material (contained in a box)
- Bundled green waste



## 2 METAL & WHITEGOODS

Council will collect up to three whitegood items or one cubic metre of metal in one collection. These collections are unlimited as this material is recycled. Please remove door seals from fridges and freezers before collection.

The following items will be collected:

- All metal goods
- Fridges
- Dryers
- Stoves
- Freezers
- Washing machines



## 3 MATTRESSES

Council will collect up to four mattresses. These collections are limited to two per year per household.

The following items will be collected:

■ All sized mattresses:

- Cot
- Single
- King single
- Double
- Queen
- King

■ Ensembles
