To book a FREE clean-up collection contact Council on 1300 36 2170.

You must comply with the following:

- Items for collection MUST ONLY be placed out the evening before the collection date. You are given this when you make your booking.
- All collection types MUST be booked separately and separated when presented to kerbside.
- Materials MUST NOT exceed two cubic metres (2m long x 1m wide x 1m high, roughly the amount contained in a box trailer load).
- Two people must be able to carry each of the items.
- Materials MUST be piled neatly on the nature strip, clear of pedestrian and vehicle access as well as obstacles including trees and powerpoles.
- Only place CORRECT items out for collection, INCORRECT items will not be collected and will be your responsibility to dispose of.

Non-compliance may result in further action being taken. Penalties may apply.
