Nominations are now open for the Liverpool NAIDOC Awards recognising the ongoing positive actions, leadership, advocacy efforts and contributions the Aboriginal Community, including Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal agencies have made to the Liverpool Community.

Awards categories are:

- 1. Individual**
- 2. Project, partnership or community group**
- 3. Service provider (open to Aboriginal & non Aboriginal)**

Terms and Conditions

- Individuals, community groups and service providers cannot self-nominate.
- Nominations can only be submitted for one (1) category.
- Nominations should be no more than 250 words.
- Photos, brochures, flyers, newspaper articles etc. can be used as supporting documentation.
- The nominations will be judged by the 2168 NAIDOC Working Group and their decision is final.
- Recipients of Liverpool NAIDOC Awards in the last two (2) years are ineligible.
- The Awards Ceremony will be held at the 2168 NAIDOC Family Fun Day celebrations on Wednesday 10 July 2019 at Miller Square from 10am to 2pm.
- Award nominees (and/or service provider delegate) must be present at the 2168 NAIDOC Family Fun Day Awards presentation.
- Award recipients must give consent to their photos being used for promotional purposes.
- Late nominations will not be accepted.
- **Nominations close COB Friday 28 June 2019.**
