	Names should be easy to pronounce and not unnecessarily long.				
	Names are not to be duplicated within 10km of the subject road and/or within the Liverpool LGA.				
	☐ If commemorating a person, the person must be deceased. Commemorative naming after a person requires the person's contribution to the local community to have been an outstanding benefit to the community, according to GNB guidelines (evidence must be required).				
	☐ The name must not have the potential to cause offence or pose a risk to public safety and service delivery, such as emergency services or mail delivery.				
	☐ Renaming of streets or parks that are already named is not encouraged due to the potential to cause a safety issue for emergency service providers.				
Historical and/or Aboriginal names are preferred. Names encouraging multiculturalism are also desirable. (Note: Failure to comply with these requirements may lead to rejection)
