Draft Conservation Zones Study & Supporting Planning Proposal

Initial Exhibition of Study & Planning Proposal

Liverpool City Council is exhibiting a draft Conservation Zones Study and Planning Proposal, which intends to apply a Conservation Zone to specific parcels of land within the *Liverpool Local Environmental Plan* 2008.

Initial feedback is invited on the Study and Planning Proposal.

What is the Liverpool Environmental Plan 2008 (LEP)?

The LEP contains controls for development, including permissible uses, maximum height of buildings and amount of floor space. These controls guide development for most of the land in the Liverpool Local Government Area.

The LEP contains various types of land use zones, including residential, industrial, commercial, recreation and conservation (i.e. environmental) zones. The land use zone determines what can be developed on a site.

What changes are proposed?

The Planning Proposal recommends the rezoning of 15 Council owned sites and 11 privately owned sites (i.e., not Council owned) to a Conservation Zone under the LEP.

The current zoning of these sites are residential, industrial, recreation or infrastructure. It is proposed to apply one of the following Conservation Zones to each site:

- C2 Environmental Conservation; or
- C3 Environmental Management.

Why are changes proposed?

Council has heard that protecting the environment, including bushland and waterways is a key priority of the community.

A review of the Conservation Zones has been undertaken to ensure that private and publicly owned land with high biodiversity values have an appropriate zone applied in the LEP.

What happens next?

Submissions from the public exhibition period will be considered and reported to a Council meeting in 2024.

If Council decides to proceed with the draft Planning Proposal, it will be submitted to the Department of Planning and Environment (DPE) for further assessment.

If the proposal is progressed by DPE, it will undergo further community engagement, followed by a second report to Council for consideration.
