- 1 woman is killed each week in Australia from Domestic and Family Violence
- 25% of Australian women have experienced physical or sexual violence by an intimate partner
- 60% of victims are currently in paid employment


The South West Sydney DFV Alliance are looking for businesses to take a lead on Domestic and Family Violence in the Liverpool Community by joining the Domestic Family Violence Workplace Charter. The Charter asks businesses to create supportive workplaces where victims feel safe to disclose, seek help and won't be at risk of losing their job while they seek to remove themselves from the violence.
